
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



Future prospects for "Medical Technology"

Despite Corona, the companies generated around 34 billion in total sales in 2021. around 3 percent higher than in 2019. Medical technology remains a growing cornerstone of the German economy, but expectations are subdued and sales growth is expected to be lower in 2022. The industry has a positive outlook for the future due to demographic trends, particularly in mature economies, and high levels of healthcare investment in many emerging markets. The market is also being driven by the increasing importance of "health" as a commodity and by new and further technological developments. However, the German medical technology industry's participation in the growth potential will increasingly depend on the European legal framework and a positive investment climate.


Future prospects for "Rehabilitation and care market"

The market for rehabilitation in Germany has a market volume of around 9 billion euros (2017) in the field of pure medical rehabilitation and will continue to grow strongly. Around 1,200 rehabilitation facilities treat 1.9 to 2 million people a year.

With a growth of 128 percent since 2000, the market for nursing care in Germany is expected to achieve total sales of 54 billion euros this year and is the third largest segment in the German healthcare system after hospitals and outpatient medical care. The market will keep growing continuously and, according to forecasts, will reach a market volume of 65 to 85 billion euros in 2030.



Future prospects for "Medical Technology"

In the long term, India remains one of the fastest growing markets for medical technology worldwide. However, the healthcare system is currently inadequately prepared for the pandemic. There are too few testing stations, laboratories, quarantine facilities and intensive care beds with respiration equipment. Accelerated by the pandemic, India plans to set up an additional 3 million hospital beds by 2025, investing a total of around USD 200 billion in state hospital infrastructure. The market remains lucrative for international manufacturers, as the import quota for medical technology products remains at a high level of 70 percent.



Brazil's market for medical technology grew in 2019 for the third year in a row. The private sector is benefiting from the recovery of the labour market and the resurgence in the number of privately insured people, while in the public sector digitisation is driving demand for medical technology. Roughly one-third of the demand for medical technology is produced locally, while the majority is imported from abroad. The pandemic, however, is driving the country back into recession and exacerbating the medical and economic crisis. The Brazilian government wants to take out a loan US\$ 36 million to strengthen the health sector project for the state of Serpipe.







Future prospects for "Medical Technology"

In China, the economy is recovering faster than expected and is gradually moving into a new post-corona reality. After around 20 percent growth last year, the country is continuing to catch up with the USA, the world's largest medical technology market. The demand for medical technology in China remains huge and ranges from high-end magnetic resonance devices and prostheses to surgical instruments and therapeutic devices. Investments are being made in modernising hospitals, e-health and geriatric care, but also in expanding preventive care. The hitherto good market position of foreign medical technology manufacturers is gradually coming under pressure, as China wants to reduce its hitherto high dependence on imports. Since 2016, China has had an ambitious healthcare program, "Healthy China 2030". The main component is improving the efficiency of healthcare in China.

Future prospects for "Medical Technology"

Thailand is relatively well positioned during the corona crisis and there is currently sufficient capacity in intensive care units. At the moment, there is high demand for medical equipment to treat Covid-19 such as infusion pumps and respiration equipment as well as consumables such as medical gloves and disinfectants. The Thai market for medical technology is considered to be the largest in Southeast Asia and analysts forecast that it will grow by 7-9 percent annually in the medium term. Medical technology imports have grown strongly in the last two years and are likely to play an important role in the long term.



Future prospects for "Medical Technology"

Although the government has so far been able to prevent the corona virus from spreading widely, the downturn in the economy is severe and a recession is likely. Colombia is considered the third largest market for medical technology in Latin America. Originally, annual growth of 6–7 percent was expected until 2023 to reach around USD 1.6 billion.

The country relies on deliveries from abroad in the medical technology sector, which last year saw growth in double figures again for the first time. Opportunities for international companies arise in particular from the great need to modernise public hospitals and private clinics. However, the continuing decline in the value of the peso is limiting spending on imported medical technology.



Future prospects for "Medical Technology"


In China, the economy is recovering faster than expected and is gradually moving into a new post-corona reality. After around 20 percent growth last year, the country is continuing to catch up with the USA, the world's largest medical technology market. The demand for medical technology in China remains huge and ranges from high-end magnetic resonance devices and prostheses to surgical instruments and therapeutic devices. Investments are being made in modernising hospitals, e-health and geriatric care, but also in expanding preventive care. The hitherto good market position of foreign medical technology manufacturers is gradually coming under pressure, as China wants to reduce its hitherto high dependence on imports. Since 2016, China has had an ambitious healthcare program, "Healthy China 2030". The main component is improving the efficiency of healthcare in China.


