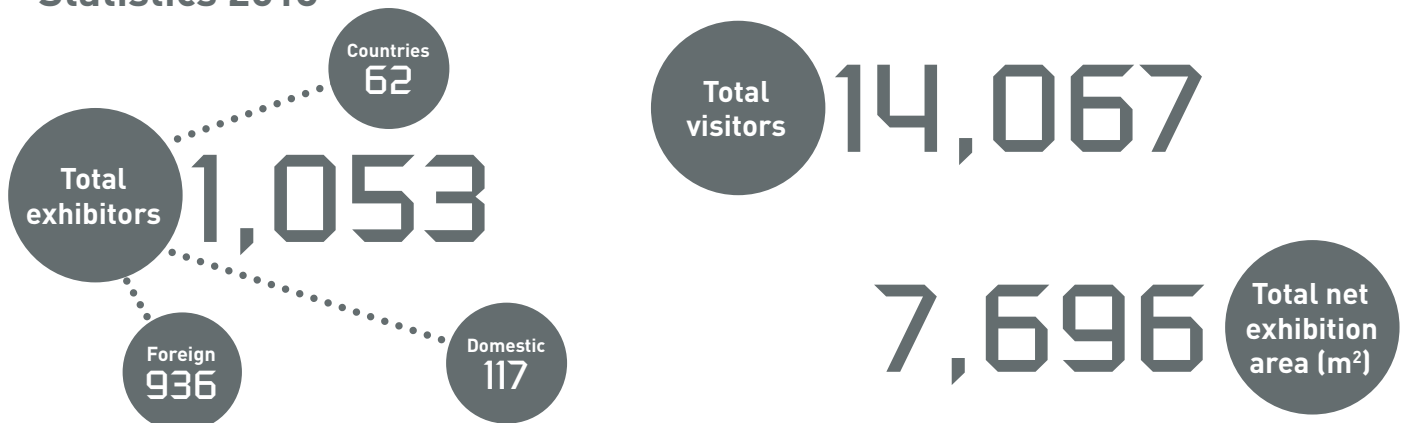

Singapore has one of the best healthcare systems in the world at its disposal and is prepared to pay for it. Singapore’s “small but fine” medical technology industry is expected to continue growing at double-digit rates in the next few years. Numerous new hospitals – the government plans to provide up to 5,000 additional hospital beds by 2030 as well as to establish a new national cancer centre. The ageing population with its diseases are also further boosting demand. The import quota remains high, so that the international manufacture of medical technology still offers the best business opportunities.

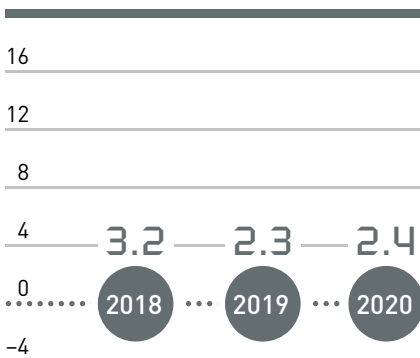

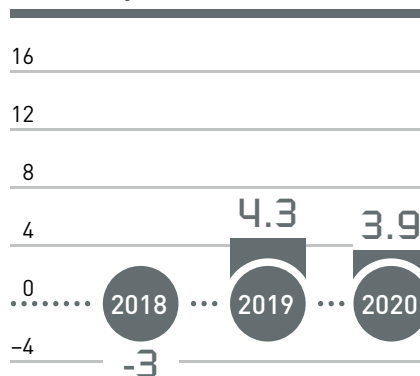

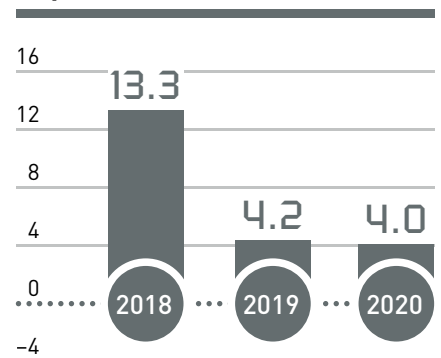
#### GDP
