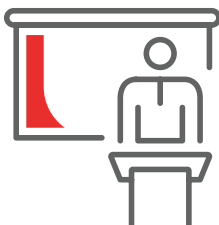

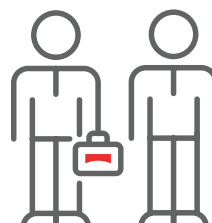

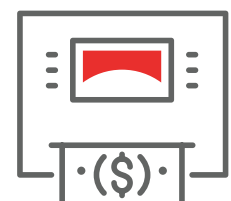

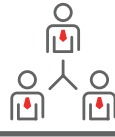
Future prospects for “Medical Technology”

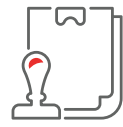

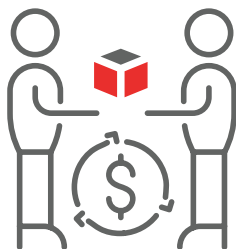
